

The Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) and has the honour to bring the attention of the Director General to the recent threats of attacks against Iran's nuclear sites, facilities, and installations by the Israeli Regime.

It is indisputable that threats of attacks against Iran's nuclear sites, facilities, and installations by this criminal regime; with an unparalleled record of non-compliance with Security Council resolutions and a long and dark catalogue of crimes and atrocities such as occupation, aggression, genocide, war crime, state-terrorism, and crimes against humanity, poses a uniquely grave threat to regional as well as international peace and security.

It is worth mentioning that as it was recognized by the IAEA General Conference's decisions and resolutions, any threat to attack nuclear facilities constitutes a violation of international law, Charter of the United Nations, and the Statute of the Agency. Moreover, it was also emphasized by NPT State Parties in the Final Document of the 2000 NPT Review Conference that "attack or threats of attack on nuclear facilities devoted to peaceful purposes jeopardize nuclear safety, have dangerous political, economic and environmental implications and raise serious concerns regarding the application of international law on the use of force in such cases, which could warrant appropriate action in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the United Nations."

In light of the current and past behavior of the Israeli regime, which has been characterized by making grave threats against the safeguarded nuclear facilities of other Member States, the Islamic Republic of Iran urgently calls upon the Director General of the IAEA to take all necessary measure and/or actions along with his responsibility, as enshrined in the Statute and other relevant GC resolutions, to confront these alarming threats emanating from this regime. The Director General is duty-bound to fulfill its responsibilities and obligations and take necessary action to secure against any threat arising from this regime to peace and security in general and the integrity of the Agency in particular.

Needless to emphasize that any kind of attack against Iran's nuclear sites, facilities, and installations, would have serious implications and trigger Iran's appropriate decisions, as such attacks or threat of attack would undoubtedly compromise Iran's peaceful nuclear activities along with safeguard obligations under CSA.

While the Islamic Republic of Iran would continue to exercise full responsibility under Charter of the United Nations and International law, in case of any miscalculations and provocative action by the Israeli regime against Iran, our response would be swift, forceful, and unequivocal, in full conformity with Iran's rights under the Charter of the United Nations.

The Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations and other International Organizations in Vienna avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency the assurances of its highest consideration.
