Excellency,

Further to our letters dated 28 February, 1 and 2 March 2026 concerning the ongoing acts of aggression by the United States and the Israeli regime against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Islamic Republic of Iran, in flagrant violation of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, I am writing to bring to the urgent attention of Your Excellency and the members of the Security Council the unlawful airstrike carried out on 2 March 2026 by the United States and the Israeli regime against the premises of the Diplomatic Police in Tehran, which resulted in the destruction of the premises in question.

This deliberate and unprovoked attack against the premises and the official authority responsible for ensuring the protection, safety, and security of foreign diplomatic and consular missions accredited to the Islamic Republic of Iran constitutes an egregious breach of international law, including the very principles enshrined in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations (1961). The destruction of this facility not only constitutes a violation of Iran's sovereignty and territorial integrity but also could jeopardise the effective protection of foreign diplomatic premises and personnel in Tehran.

The Islamic Republic of Iran urges the Secretary-General and the Security Council—entrusted under the Charter of the United Nations with the primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security—to condemn the ongoing acts of aggression against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Islamic Republic of Iran. The members of the Security Council must compel the United States and the Israeli regime to comply fully with their international legal obligations and to immediately cease their unlawful and criminal acts of aggression, which undoubtedly constitute an unprecedented threat to regional and international peace and security.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as an official document of the Security Council and the General Assembly under agenda item 84, entitled “The rule of law at the national and international levels.”
