Excellency,

Upon instructions from my Government, and further to our previous communications dated 28 February and 1, 2 and 3 March 2026 concerning the ongoing acts of aggression and unprovoked war by the United States and the Israeli regime against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Islamic Republic of Iran, in flagrant violation of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, I write to bring to your urgent attention, and to that of the members of the Security Council, a grave and unlawful threat of the use of force by the Israeli regime against the diplomatic premises and personnel of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Lebanon.

On Tuesday, 3 March 2026, the official spokesperson of the armed forces of the Israeli regime publicly issued a direct threat to target the official representatives of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Lebanon. An explicit 24-hour ultimatum was reportedly issued, demanding that Iranian representatives leave the territory of Lebanon, coupled with a declared intention to carry out an attack in the event of non-compliance.

Such a threat to use force against the official representatives of a sovereign State on the territory of another sovereign State constitutes a flagrant violation of international law and of the Charter of the United Nations. The inviolability of diplomatic premises and personnel is absolute under international law. The Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961, which codifies fundamental principles of customary international law, unequivocally affirms that the premises of a diplomatic mission and its agents are inviolable.

The Islamic Republic of Iran unequivocally and in the strongest possible terms condemns these unlawful, reckless, and dangerous threats. Such conduct reflects a continuing and systematic pattern of contempt by the Israeli regime for the Charter of the United Nations, the established norms of international law, and the most fundamental rules governing diplomatic protection.



In light of the gravity of this situation, the Islamic Republic of Iran calls upon the Secretary-General and the members of the Security Council to:

1. Explicitly and unequivocally condemn the threat of the use of force against the diplomatic premises and personnel of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Lebanon; and
2. Demand and force the Israeli regime to immediately cease and refrain from any action or threat directed against Iran's diplomatic premises and personnel.

The Israeli regime will bear full responsibility for the consequences of any attack, damage, intrusion, or harm inflicted upon the diplomatic premises or personnel of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

The Islamic Republic of Iran has formally notified the Government of Lebanon, as the receiving State, of its obligations under the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961 and has called upon it to undertake all necessary and immediate measures to ensure the full safety and security of Iranian diplomats, embassy staff, and diplomatic and consular premises, in strict conformity with its international legal obligations.

I would be grateful if you would circulate the present letter as an official document of the Security Council.
