Excellency,

Upon instructions from my Government, and pursuant to my previous letters dated 3, 7, 16, 26, 30, 31 March and 6 April 2026, I wish to inform you and the members of the Security Council of the following:

Based on continuing monitoring and assessments conducted by the Armed Forces of the Islamic Republic of Iran, it has been ascertained that the aggressor, namely the United States, has continued to use the territory and airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for the planning, preparation, equipping, and execution of unlawful military attacks against the Islamic Republic of Iran. Some specific instances are as follows:

- At 00:58 on 3 April 2026, United States F-15E and F-16SV fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- From 01:00 on 3 April 2026, United States U-2S reconnaissance aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- From 06:10 on 3 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- At 06:46 on 3 April 2026, United States F-35 fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- At 07:46 on 3 April 2026, United States F-22 fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;



- At 09:16 on 3 April 2026, United States F-35 and F-16SV fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- From 11:00 on 3 April 2026, United States MQ-4C reconnaissance drone, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- From 11:50 on 3 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- From 13:30 on 3 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- At 16:06 on 3 April 2026, United States F-15E and F-16SV fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- From 17:59 on 3 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- At 19:10 on 3 April 2026, United States F-35 and F-16SV fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- From 19:30 on 3 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- From 22:50 on 3 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;



- At 00:58 on 4 April 2026, United States F-15E and F-16SV fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- From 05:40 on 4 April 2026, United States E-11A communications relay aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- From 06:24 on 4 April 2026, United States AWACS command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- At 10:37 on 4 April 2026, United States MQ-4 reconnaissance drone, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- At 11:15 on 4 April 2026, United States MQ-4C reconnaissance drone, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;
- At 11:30 on 4 April 2026, United States F-15E and F-35 fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- At 13:02 on 4 April 2026, United States F-35 fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- At 14:50 on 4 April 2026, United States MQ-9 drone, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran;
- From 14:50 on 4 April 2026, United States AWACS-E3 command-and-control aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, provided intelligence support to United States fighter jets;



- At 23:11 on 4 April 2026, United States B-1 bomber aircraft, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran; and
- At 23:25 on 4 April 2026, United States F-15E fighter jets, utilising and transiting the airspace of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, carried out bombing raids on targets inside the Islamic Republic of Iran.

In light of the international responsibility of States arising from placing their territory at the disposal of others for the commission of acts of aggression and the conduct of armed attacks against the territory of a third State, the Islamic Republic of Iran expresses its strong and unequivocal objection to the aforementioned unlawful actions and strictly calls upon the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to observe the principles of good neighbourliness and to prevent the continued use of its territory against the Islamic Republic of Iran.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
